

Preception of local Agricultural Extension Officials in some governorates of Egypt For Communication skills in the body language

Abstract

The aims of the research were to determine the :Preception degree of the skill of communicating with the body language, the degree of each skill in the language of the body, the relation between the Preception degree the communication skills in the body language and the independent variables studied. The body and the independent variables studied.

The research was conducted in the governorates of Matrouh, Port Said Aswan and Sohag. The respondents included all those responsible for agricultural extension work in agricultural departments at the level of administrative centers in the governorates of the study.

Data was collected by personal interview using a questionnaire form designed to achieve the research objectives. the Frequencies, percentages, mean arithmetic, range, and Pearson's simple correlation coefficient to presentation and analysis of data.

The main findings were summarized as follows:

- 1- (36.7%) of the respondents have an average perception of ommunication skills in body language.
- 2 - perception of each communication skill in body language was moderate to facial expression, low for both hand expressions and expressions of different gestures of the body.
- 3- relation between the perception of degree of respondents to the skills of communication in body language and all independent variables studied
- 4- The Preception degree of respondents of facial expressions was related to all independent variables studied.
- 5- The Preception degree of respondents to the expressions of hands were linked to all independent variables studied.
- 6- The Preception degree of respondents to the expressions of some different gestures of the body was linked to all the independent variables studied.
